They weren't 100% sure so we arranged for them to meet Tilly the following day to see what they thought. If they still weren't sure or there wasn't that bond there then no problem – Tilly would still have her place in the foster home.

We took Tilly to meet Jim and Ann and they instantly fell in love. They adopted her on the spot and whilst Anne signed the paperwork, Jim took Tilly out for a walk. Neither of them could understand how a lovely, obedient and friendly dog could be knowingly left at the pound by her owners.

A few days later Tilly went to the vets for her 2nd Vaccination and what a difference there is. She has put on weight and looks so much better. Jim and Anne keep saying how they can't believe that anyone could let a dog like Tilly go. They are really thrilled with her and Tilly looks really happy and content.
